

### **History**

My father was a returned serviceman and over his farming career put together the original Glenbrae farm of 400 acres - a mixed dairy and sheep farm. The benefits of cross breeding were highlighted to me at a young age. As a 18 year old my father allowed me to select sires to mate with his 90 dairy cows.

I selected high value AI sires and crossed Jersey and Friesian, dependent on the fat content in their milk. The percentage of each breed did not matter. There was an immediate lift in production from each crop of heifers introduced into the herd.

A very high producing herd was sold six years later in 1975.

# The lucky generation

Looking back I consider myself one of the lucky generation who started sheep farming at a time when the government of the day provided concessional loans for young farmers aspiring to farm ownership. I was able to purchase a 500 acre property 5 kilometers away from my father's 400 acre block qualifying for the governments 85% loan scheme at the time. With the purchase of this property sheep and cattle farming began on a larger scale and in earnest.

Like most young farmers starting out I was only able to purchase very average ewes and cows. After 3 years farming we had put together 120 Angus cross cows. At that time my neighbour Tom Checkley, a very good stockman, was topping the Masterton weaner fair with lovely Angus Hereford calves.

I knew I would need to breed cows for probably 20 years or more if I wanted to compete with Tom at the weaner fair.

### **Clay university**

During these early years I read data from Clay University in America where different breeds were compared over a range of attributes. The two top performing breeds were Simmental and Angus, particularly in relation to grass fed conditions in New Zealand. Both breeds were strong maternally, Simmentals were bigger and had greater growth, while the Angus were medium framed and required less maintenance. Both had good carcass attributes. I thought that these two breeds would complement each other.

A few Simmental herds had been established in NZ. I went to a bull sale, purchased 3 Simmental bulls, went home and put 3 Angus bulls in the works the next day (much to my father's horror).

And so, began 40 years of crossbreeding.

Over the years as the farm grew, so did the cow herd. For many years now we have run 1000 cows. While building up the herd capital stock cows of various breeds were purchased. All were mated to top performing bulls, however none compared with the Simmental Angus cows.

### **Top Genetics**

From the early years I have had an intense interest in genetics. With significant mortgage's that go with expanding farms, establishing a highly productive ewe flock and cow herd was of the upmost importance.

'2018 saw an average price of \$1380 for 157 weaners.

2019 saw an average price of \$1180 for 169 weaners (top pen sold for \$1300.00)'

#### **Climate**

Farms on the east coast of the North Island are subjected to varying seasonal conditions, and from time to time ewes and cows must survive and thrive in adverse conditions.

In such times the constitution and do-ability of the breeding stock are tested.

The cows that come through time and time again, rearing good calves every year are those with strong confirmation, deep bodies and square backends. This is what we have endeavored to breed.

#### Cattle

At our Glenbrae property heifers and second calvers have always been mated to Angus bulls. Mixed age cows have been mated to Simmental and Angus bulls. Replacements are selected on their merits regardless of whether they are from heifers or mixed age cows

Cows and heifers have varying percentages of Angus and Simmental in them. Traditional cattlemen have always questioned where you go after the first cross. The answer is back to whichever breed you wish to influence the next generation. I think we have proved this with commercial success. Our hill country weaners have topped the Masterton weaner fair for 30 odd years and often achieved the highest prices in NZ.



### **Property overview**

Over the years Helen and I increased the size of Glenbrae to 4000 acres. Johnie has taken it to 4500 acres. Other properties have been leased and purchased, the most significant purchase being Glenburn station in 2007.

The two properties Glenbrae and Glenburn run 11000 ewes, over 1100 cows and all supporting stock. All lambs and some cattle are finished.

### **McFadzean Family**

Helen and I have one daughter, Tessa (33), a Marketing Manager with Fonterra and three sons, Johnie (35), Lachie (30), and Corey (28). All three sons are farming.

Lachie and I co-manage Glenburn with the help of three

Corey is shepherding at Wairere north of Masterton.

All three boys are as enthusiastic about farming as I am and are very capable hill country farmers and stockmen.

Taking breeding to another level, recording and DNA testing cattle has been Johnie's initiative backed up by his wife Laura and his two brothers.

The team is keen to build on a solid foundation, set down over 40 years, and provide another option to commercial cattle

### McFadzean **Breeding objectives**

#### The cow herd is the foundation of a breeding operation.

#### At Glenbrae

- ✓ We have mated yearling heifers for nearly 40 years.
- ✓ Any yearlings that do not get in calf are culled.
- ✓ Any cows that do not rear calves are culled.
- ✓ Any cows that rear substandard calves are culled.
- ✓ All cattle culled on temperament.

#### Criteria when purchasing sire bulls:

- Top EBV's
- Growth
- Fertility
- Milk
- Smooth shoulder
- Good EMA
- Width and muscle through the loins
- Length from hip to pin
- Temperament
- Positive fats
- Good IMF

The key ingredient is being consistent when purchasing new sires each year and using the same criteria for both breeds.

We endeavor to purchase the bulls that fulfill our criteria. We have paid up to \$20,000.00 for individual bulls and spend around \$100,000.00 on bulls annually.

Not all bulls prove successful, and no matter what we have paid they will be culled if they do not perform.

#### Maternal or terminal?

The cows are bred to be successful maternally. Cows that do not rear good calves are culled.

Bulls with a greater percentage of Angus will have a positive effect on calf size, milk production and muscling, without being detrimental to the cow's constitution.

Bulls with a greater percentage of Simmental will have a substantial effect on calf size, growth and muscling, but if replacements are kept the cows will be a little bigger and heavier.

Recently a visiting Canadian Angus breeder told us that Angus cattle with varying degrees of Simmental in them are fetching premiums across Canada.



### McFadzean **Meat Maker Bulls**

#### The bulls

We selected 58 out of 540 calves, the remainder being sold as weaners. The bulls were picked on structure and muscling, they were not necessarily the biggest calves. We identified the bulls that we would be happy to use ourselves.

#### **Colours**

When crossing Simmental and Angus the Sires colour is not necessarily dominant, for example a 3/4 Angus can be red, in most cases a dark red. A 3/4 Simmental can be grey.

#### **DNA testing**

All bull calves were DNA recorded at tagging in January

Potential sale bulls were selected late February while still on their mothers

#### Sire bulls

Sire bulls were DNA tested January, unfortunately two very good Sires were injured during mating and culled, hence there are several bulls catalogued with "Sire unidentified".

#### **Heifer mating**

We do not recommend that these bulls be mated with yearlings. At this point we do not have enough recorded information to guarantee birth weight and ease of calving enabling bulls to be sold as suitable for mating with yearling heifers.



#### **Past sales**

We have sold a few bulls over the last 10 years to farmers who wanted to infuse McFadzean genetics into their herds, or to use the bulls as terminal sires. They have been successful.

2018 bulls: Farmers who purchased bulls last year have reported very good in calf rates and very few injuries.

**2019 bulls:** After a dry summer and autumn this year's sale bulls are slightly ahead in yearling weight and ahead in daily weight gain over winter. There are definitely some useful bulls in this year's line-up.

#### **Animal health**

#### Sale bulls have had:

- Two BVD shots
- Semen tested
- Testicles palpated
- Penis examined
- Cydectin pour on

#### All bulls are guaranteed.

- Any issues phone immediately.
- We will endeavor to get you a replacement.

#### Sale bull information

- Calving starts around July 25. Some short gestation heifers a few days earlier.
- The mean calving date for the herd is August 20.
- Average weaning weight April 26 402kgs.
- Average yearling weight August 11 547kgs.
- Average daily weight gain 1.35kgs per day.
- We expect the average weight to be 600kg+ by sale day (13 months old).

### Information with each Meat Maker bull

Weaning weight (WW) - An indication of the calf's ability to grow and the cows milking ability.

**Yearling weight (YW)** - A true indication of the bull's ability to grow.

**Daily weight gain (DWG)** - The average daily weight gain achieved by the bull from weaning to yearling.

Scanning data as at 3/8/19

Eye muscle area (EMA) – An indication of muscling in animal. More positive numbers indicate better muscling on animals.

Rib fat (RF) - A measurement at the 12-13th rib, more positive numbers indicate more subcutaneous fat and earlier maturity.

Rump Fat (P8 Fat) – A measurement at the P8 site, more positive numbers indicate more subcutaneous fat and earlier maturity

Intramuscular Fat (IMF) - A measurement of marbling through the meat, more positive numbers indicate a greater degree of marbling through the carcass. Marbling scores range between 1 and 8 with 8 being extremely high.

### **Terms & conditions**

The New Zealand Stock & Station Agent's Association Conditions of Sale and, to the extent deemed relevant by PGG Wrightson Limited (PGW), PGW's Terms of Sale apply to this sale. When proceeds are credited or a purchase is debited to a PGW monthly credit account, then PGW's Monthly Account Terms of Trade (as amended from time to time) apply to the extent deemed relevant by PGW. - We expect bulls to be delivered around 24th-28th September 2019.
- Bulls will not be trucked with other stock. Martinborough transport is the nominated carrier.
- Cartage will be paid to Taihape, Gisborne and Temuka.
- All non-participating agents will receive 7% rebate.
- Deferred payment; A Deferred Payment option as available if required.

### **Bulls on arrival**

Please have some other cattle present when your bulls arrive as travel can be unsettling for a new bull in a strange environment.

#### Taking care of your bull

- Young animals require drenching following mating.
- We do not recommend that bulls be mated with yearling heifers. We do not have enough recorded background information to recommend them for yearling mating.
- Mating second calvers onwards is fine.
- We believe that an infusion of these genetics will boost production in most herds both maternally and productively.

#### Guarantees

All McFadzean Meat-Makers are guaranteed for 2 years from the date of sale against structural unsoundness, infertility or incapability of service. Under these circumstances McFadzean Cattle Company will:

Replace the bull with a satisfactory substitute if available, or; Issue a credit equal to the purchase price less the salvage value. This credit may be used at future McFadzean Cattle Company sales. This guarantee covers the purchase value of the bull without interest, cost or damages.

The guarantee shall apply providing bulls incapacity is not caused by injury or disease contracted since leaving Glenbrae.

A veterinary certificate must be supplied by the purchaser upon request. If any bull that is purchased does not possess a reasonable fertility, although not totally infertile, any dispute that may arise shall be settled by an arbitrator appointed by that auctioneers and must be lodged within 12 Calendar months from date of sale.

#### **Insurance**

We recommend that all purchasers discuss injury insurance of their bulls at the sale. Aon will be in attendance.

#### Health status

- The cattle are C10
- The bulls have had two BVD vaccinations

#### **Health and safety**

The vendors have done all possible to ensure the safety of all visitors. It must be recognised that this is a working farm property environment with animals. All visitors should ensure their own personal safety.
